For the last 16 years, Dr. Greer has also been a consultant at the Adult Correctional Institute in Cranston, Rhode Island. He is a Clinical Assistant Professor of Psychiatry at Brown University. Previously, Dr. Greer was an Assistant Professor Psychiatry of Pediatrics at Tulane University in New Orleans, and the Director of the Adolescent Dual Diagnoses Unit at the New Orleans Adolescent Hospital.
